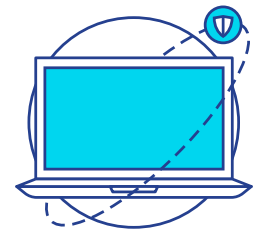
### Support safe and healthy students
